STUDENT - TECHNOLOGY ACCEPTABLE USE POLICY (AUP)

I verify that I have reviewed the District's Policy and Procedures 2022 for Electronic Resources (available at www.asd5.org) and will follow any school building guidelines as well as the District guidelines listed in this policy.

I acknowledge and agree that I should not have any expectation of privacy when using the district's devices, network system, email, information stored locally on district servers or with service providers that work with the District where applicable. I acknowledge and agree that the District and District staff may use various means to monitor user activity, devices and network traffic. The district reserves the right to disclose any electronic documents and data to law enforcement officials or third parties as appropriate. All documents are subject to review by district staff at any time and the public disclosure laws of the State of Washington as applicable.

The District reserves the right to filter content and restrict access as necessary for compliance and/or when such content is deemed of non-academic value. While such systems may be in use, they are not without potential technical issues, as such the District cannot be responsible for all content possibly accessible to students. The District will make every effort, where feasible, in good faith to create a safe and compliant academic environment for all users.

I acknowledge that the District has my consent to approve the use of additional third party service providers on my behalf when deemed of educational value and appropriate to academic goals and outcomes. I acknowledge that the district has my consent to share student work locally and with third parties. I acknowledge that the use of such systems may be at the terms of use and privacy policies of the third party services providers.

The District uses Google Workspace for Education. I acknowledge that the district has my consent to provide and manage an account for my student which may use and access a number of systems and services related to their Google Education account. This may include gmail, docs, classroom, etc. and other additional services such as Youtube.

All users of the district's electronic resources are responsible for the care of their device(s). Users who intentionally damage such resources and are found at fault may be subject to fees or fines to repair or replace such devices. I acknowledge and accept such responsibility.

Violation of any of the district's policies and procedures may result in disciplinary action including, but not limited to: suspension of network privileges, computer or device access privileges, and/or termination of employment.

I hereby waive any right of privacy to any and all material located in any location through the use of district equipment and networks. I give consent for the District to share my information as deemed appropriate to third party services providers as necessary and appropriate to the educational goals of the district. **I attest that I am legally able to agree to this policy as the student and/or for my student.**

Enrollment in the Aberdeen School District assumes opt-in to these policies. **Students who do not have a signed, current AUP on file may not be issued a school device and will have accounts disabled on, or after October 1st of each year.** If you do not wish to agree to the student acceptable use policy you may submit a formal request to your student's school before October 1st of each school year.

The Aberdeen School District board of directors recognizes that an effective public education system develops students who are globally aware, civically engaged, and capable of managing their lives and careers. The board also believes that students need to be proficient and safe users of information, media, and technology to succeed in a digital world. As a network user on the Aberdeen School District No. 5 network, I will follow the building and District guidelines. I also understand and will abide by the following expectations:

1. Review District Policy 2022 (available at www.asd5.org) and accompanying procedures
2. Keep my logins and password secure and safe, I will not share my passwords, If I believe my account is compromised I will let the school know to have it reset
3. Use all computers and other technology in a safe and responsible manner in accordance with my academic goals
4. Not use social media for harassment, cyber-bullying, or unethical practices
5. Obey all school rules concerning internet use, using my device only for my educational goals
6. Use the District network and the Internet for school-related activities and projects only
7. Contact an administrator or teacher about any security problems
8. Contact an administrator or teacher if I receive inappropriate messages
9. Will not attempt to bypass or get around District monitoring systems, content filter or security protocols
10. Will not add any software or connect other systems to my district issued devices
11. Return any borrowed or checked out technology in good condition
12. Complete any required lessons in the classroom or advisory on network and computer use

Any attempts to defeat or circumvent the network security, or disregard acceptable use procedures, is a violation of policy and may result in loss of network and Internet access privileges as well as device usage while in the Aberdeen School District.

These systems may change year to year depending on academic initiatives, program changes and service providers offerings. In many cases the District must acknowledge they have parental consent for students to use such systems.
