## Student ID Policy

### Public / Student-Facing Policy

All Eules Junior High students are required to wear a school-issued ID badge at all times when in the school building.

7th: White    8th: Black    9th: Red





Disciplinary Actions	
1st time	Student can retrieve their device at the end of the school day from the downstairs office
2nd time	A parent or guardian must retrieve the device. A 30-minute detention is assigned.
3rd time	A parent or guardian must retrieve the device. A 1-hour detention is assigned.
4th time	A parent or guardian must retrieve the device. A 2-hour detention is assigned.
5th time	A parent or guardian must retrieve the device. ISS is assigned. The student must turn in their device to the front office each day for the remainder of the year.

# How to sign up for Free/Reduce Lunch

The 89th Texas Legislature approved funding through the General Appropriations Act to ensure that students who qualify for reduced-price school meals can receive both breakfast and lunch at no cost for the next two years. State funding for reduced-price meals took effect on September 1, 2025. If you have already applied for and been approved for reduced-price meals, no action is needed.
