Chadwick International is a PreK-12 non-profit, coeducational international school in Incheon, South Korea. Chadwick International (CI) opened in 2010 as the sister campus of Chadwick School in Palos Verdes, CA, established in 1935. CI's Class of 2016 was the first cohort to graduate. CI is an authorized IB World School offering the Primary Years Programme (PYP), the Middle Years Programme (MYP), the Diploma Programme (DP), and the Career-Related Programme (IBCP). All students receive a U.S. high school diploma and English is the medium of instruction. Chadwick International is regionally accredited by the Western Association of Schools and Colleges (WASC).

◆ CURRICULUM

Academic Policy

Grade 11 and 12 students choose to take the IB Diploma Programme, the IB Career-related Program or some IB Courses along with non-IB courses, all which lead to a U.S. high school diploma. CI requires that students in the IBDP take no more than three HL classes. Students are NOT ranked at Chadwick International and we do not calculate or provide GPA's. Students receive one final report (June) and one mid-year progress report (January). Students who transfer into CI mid-year will earn a Pass for courses on their final report. Students are required to study MYP subjects in Grade 9&10 and complete a Personal Project (Grade 10).

Diploma Requirements

All CI graduates receive a U.S. high school diploma. A minimum of 22 year-long credits are required for graduation (20 for students with approved accommodations). Students with Individualized Education Plans (IEPs) or English as a Second Language (ESL) learning plans may graduate with modified credit requirements, determined in collaboration with support services and administration.

Special Notes for the Chadwick MYP Math and Science Curricula

* The MYP Math curriculum integrates Algebra I & II, Geometry, and Trigonometry. The Standard Math Pathway is based on the Standard Common Core curriculum. The Extended Pathway is based on the Accelerated Common Core curriculum.

** The MYP Science curriculum integrates Biology, Chemistry, and Physics; this integrated curriculum is deepened and enriched over the years. The sequence is required and each year's course is a laboratory science course.

Graduation Requirements

Students must fulfill Outdoor Education and Community Service requirements.

Outdoor Education

Chadwick Schools' unique yearly Outdoor Education program encourages students in Grades 4-12, to live our Mission statement through extended and challenging small-group expeditions in the wilderness.

Community Service

Chadwick International requires students to contribute to their community through volunteer activities. In these educational experiences, students apply what they are learning in class to community problems and reflect upon their experiences in order to gain a deeper understanding of skills and concepts in the community. The program seeks to foster in our students a lifelong, active commitment to service.
