Mrs. Southern introduced the new staff members to NISD. She also stated that NISD is fully staffed, and we currently have 183 students for 25-26 enrollment. Dr. Gajewsky stated that he spoke with VISD transportation, and they will pick up the students at NISD for Cade and West, pending final approval. The NISD buses are scheduled to arrive in the next few days, pending installation of the locks. NISD received the MOU from Cuero for Special Education transportation, and the cost is \$44,845 for the 2025-2026 school year. Dr. Gajewsky provided an update on the facilities and what was needed, specifically the electricity, to allow all the other items to be completed. Lots of work must be done, and the rain continues to halt progress. Finally, two new bills will require board action in the near future: SB 401 and a bill regarding student cell phones.

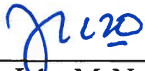
