Community

Bradley-Bourbonnais Community High School serves the communities of Bourbonnais, Bradley, and St. George, with a combined population of over 30,000. These communities are located approximately 55 miles south of Chicago. Major industries in the surrounding community include healthcare, manufacturing, biomedical, and higher education.

School

Bradley-Bourbonnais Community High School is a four-year comprehensive high school with 115 licensed teachers, the majority of whom hold at least a Master's degree. BBCHS operates on a semester-based school year, with two 18-week semesters. The academic day is divided into seven 50-minute periods with classes meeting five days per week. Full-time students enroll in six classes each semester, with the seventh period serving as lunch/study hall. Students also have an option of enrolling in a seventh "early bird"/zero hour class at the start of their day. Students earn ½ credit per semester for each course successfully completed. All students also participate in Boiler Block, a 35-minute daily period designed to personalize the school experience and enhance the sense of community through advisory, academic support and enrichment. BBCHS is a member school of the Kankakee Area Regional Vocational Education System and the Kankakee Community College District. The 2025-2026 enrollment at BBCHS is 1812 students, including 406 freshman, 451 sophomores, 449 juniors, and 506 seniors.

In partnership with both Kankakee Community College and Olivet Nazarene University, BBCHS offers junior and senior students the opportunity to begin their college experience while finishing their high school diploma. Qualified students enroll in BBCHS for 2 classes per day and spend the rest of their school day on campus at either KCC or ONU. Students enrolled at KCC or ONU take general education courses designed to help them progress to a bachelors degree at the school of their choice. These college courses are weighted in the GPA.
