Proposition 1 - Building for Learning

The bond will:



Build a new middle school #5



Replace the 58-year old Cascade Middle School



Replace the 53-year old Alpac Elementary School



Reduce overcrowding at <u>all</u> four middle schools

- 1,100+ students over capacity
- 43 portables at middle schools
- Increase capacity



Modernize Learning Environments

- Improved Career & Technical Educational Spaces
- Modern technology
- Modern safety and security standards
- Efficient heating, cooling and lighting
- Better parking and access
- Updated playground and athletic fields for school and community use

Estimated Tax Rate

This is a 20-year bond with an estimated cost of \$1.04 per \$1,000 of assessed valuation.

Or approximately \$52.00 per month for the average Auburn home.



The total amount will not exceed \$490 million.

Overall Tax Rate Information - If both propositions pass, the estimated increase is \$1.29 per/\$1,000 of assessed valuation due to paying off other debt and the proposed construction schedule.

Proposition 2 - Safety, Security, Facility Improvements & Technology Replacement Levy

Proposition 2 will improve safety and security, make facility improvements in teaching and learning environments and replace the expiring technology levy.

District-wide highlights include:

- Secure entry vestibules
- · Card access system for exterior doors
- Security fencing
- Air conditioning
- Replacement of Technology Levy to support <u>all</u> students

THIS IS A 6-YEAR LEVY

Total cost will not exceed \$110.8 million.

Technology Replacement Levy is \$57.4 million.



The expiring technology levy is 26 cents per/\$1,000.

New technology levy is 40 cents per/\$1,000 - a 14-cent increase. Safety, Security and Facility Improvements levy is \$53.4 million.

This portion of the levy is 37 cents per/\$1,000.
