Dear Parents/Guardians and Staff:

This letter, in accordance with regulations adopted by the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection (NJDEP) shall serve to notify you of Mount Olive's Public Schools pest control policy.

The State of New Jersey's Administrative Code Section 7:30-13.1, outlines the scope and purpose of Integrated Pest Management (IPM) Policy requirements for New Jersey schools. This section of the law mandates that schools develop and implement an IPM Policy and Plan to minimize pest problems and reduce pesticide use, ensuring the health and safety of students, staff, and the environment. It further mandates that an Integrated Pest Management Coordinator be named, the licensing required of any applicator and the timely notification to parents /guardians of enrolled students and staff of any applications

Mount Olive Schools has adopted a model plan developed by the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection Pesticide Control Program and the Rutgers Cooperative Extension Pest Management Office.

Integrated Pest Management (IPM) on school property is a long-term approach to maintaining healthy landscapes & facilities that minimizes risks to people and the environment.

In keeping with our IPM guidelines there may be a need to provide notice of pesticide applications at the schools either prior to or after said application. In an effort to mitigate any exposure, we have relegated applications of non-low impact pesticides to after students/staff have departed for the day and only by a License 13 holder.

All Records of any pesticide applications within a Mt. Olive school shall be kept/updated in the required IPM Binder located in the Main Office of each school here in the district.
