**Richmond County School System to provide fee lunch
through Community Eligibility Provision**

(AUGUSTA, GEORGIA) – For the 2022-2023 school year, Richmond County School System students in eligible schools will receive free lunch through the Community Eligibility Provision.

During the pandemic, the federal government provided free lunch to all schools. Beginning this school year, our school system will return to the Community Eligibility Program and federal school lunch program funding will return to pre-pandemic guidelines.

Families with students attending Davidson Fine Arts School, Freedom Park K-8 School and/ or C.T. Walker Magnet School are requested to complete the Free and Reduced Lunch Application online or at the school during Open House. The Free/Reduced Meal Applications can be completed online at rcboe.org/schoolnutrition

Student free and reduced lunch status from the 2019-2020 school year will apply for the first 30 days of school.

All RCSS students will receive free breakfast meals.
