CELL PHONE POLICY

In order to help student better learn, socialize, and communicate effectively in school, the Richland School District approved a new cell phone policy last year.

- **No Phones/Earbuds allowed during class time.**
- **Smart watches allowed on person, but not for communication.**
- **Earbuds may connect to chromebooks with teacher permission.**

Students must have phones put away—not on their person—during class time (in backpacks, a locked cupboard, etc.) This includes if they are in the hallways, bathrooms, or other areas of the campus during class time. During breaks and at lunch, students are more than welcome to utilize their phones to contact parents, workplaces, etc. We greatly appreciate the support of our parent community as we work to create an environment more conducive to learning and socialization in our classrooms.

Important Notes About FinalForms Status

When registering your student-athlete in FinalForms, you'll see four status indicators. For your student to be fully approved for participation, all four status indicators must be green:

- Forms Signed by Parent
 - Forms Signed by Student
 - Physical Status - The physical must be uploaded and reviewed/approved by the athletic department.
 - Fees Paid - All fees must be paid prior to the first practice for your student to participate, no exceptions

Participation Checklist: What's Required to Practice & Compete

To participate on the first day of practice, students must:

- Register in FinalForms
- Note: FamilyID/Arbiter is no longer used
- Submit a Valid Sports Physical
 - Upload directly to FinalForms
 - Physicals are valid for 2 years
 - Sports Physical Form
- Pay ASB & Sports Fees (available starting August 1 via InTouch)
 - ASB Fee: \$30
 - Sports Fee: \$55
 - Online Payment Link
