Where: Eastmont Orchards, 321 County Rd 537, Colts Neck, NJ



# **Pre-K Curriculum Connection**



The Tools of the Mind curriculum is an innovative early childhood education approach that focuses on building executive function skills and self-regulation in preschool children. Based on the work of psychologist Lev Vygotsky, this curriculum helps children

develop cognitive tools to manage their attention, memory, and behavior through structured play and learning activities. The curriculum integrates academic learning with social-emotional development, fostering creativity, problem-solving, and the foundational skills children need for future success.

Our first theme this school year, which will be starting in a few weeks, is <u>Family and Me!</u> Please bring in a family picture to give to your learner's teacher during the first few weeks of school (or email a digital version) so we can proudly display them on our community pod bulletin boards! Who doesn't love to see their family showcased on the bulletin board at school?
