2025-26 CIP Goals

By May 2026, the percentage of proficient students in grades 3 - 6 will increase a minimum of 5% over the May 2025 school-wide results as measured by Arizona's Academic Standards Assessment (AASA) in **math**.

By May 2026, the percentage of proficient students in grades 3 - 6 will increase a minimum of 5% over the May 2025 school-wide results as measured by Arizona's Academic Standards Assessment (AASA) in **reading**. By May 2026, the percentage of students in grades K-3 will decrease a minimum of 5% in the well-below category compared to the May 2025 school-wide results as measured by DIBELS in **reading**.

By May 2026, 100% of **families will engage** with school communication and have the opportunity to actively participate in a minimum of one structured academic event that focuses directly on student learning as measured by attendance sheets.

Information about Title I

- Schools who qualify receive federal funding (Title I money) to supplement the school's existing programs. These dollars are used for:
 - Intervention for academic and behavior
 - Purchasing supplemental staff / programs / materials / supplies
 - Conducting additional parental involvement meetings / trainings / activities
 - Recruiting / Hiring / Retaining Highly Qualified Teachers

Requirements for Title I

At least 40% low income student population - identified by Free/Reduced lunch #s.

Conduct a Comprehensive Needs Assessment based on data.

Create goals and action steps based on CNA.

Align the school budget to goals and action steps.



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
Rights of Parents to Be Involved
