




Waive your rights and sign the FERPA to allow your transcripts and letters of recommendation to be sent! No transcripts can be sent without the FERPA!



Email your signed FERPA Waiver to the counseling secretary or drop off in the main office!

Ms. Gemmel emailed the FERPA form to all of you in August

Go to <u>www.sbctc.edu</u> to research and find the right match. There are 34 C/T options in WA.

After January 1, 2026, fill out the fall application. Check the college's website for **priority deadlines**. Bellevue College priority deadline is in mid May.

Register to take a placement test, if needed (English and math).

Meet with an academic advisor at the college to discuss class and career path.



- Bellevue College is an open admissions institution
- BC is offering a fall application workshop on campus in Nov.please watch for an invitation!
- BC has a partnership with Eastern WA University and offer 14 bachelor degree programs. These are 4-year degrees
- BC offers an Occupational Life Services and Neurodiversity Navigators program for neurodiverse students
- BC offers on campus housing for students
- BC is a great school to finish the first two years of a 4-year degree and then transfer to a 4-year college or university
- BC is home of the Bulldogs, including 11 men's and women's sports team that have earned regional and national awards

No counselor/teacher letter of recommendation needed for most public colleges. Many are test optional or test blind this year. But most still require essays!

Essential SHS Information to fill out your Common Application! Look for this in your **Teams** Channel and over email!

University of Washington Seattle

- ➤ UW has two options to apply: Common APP <u>Common App website</u> or Apply Web <u>applyweb</u>
- > UW has two required essays. Students must all prepare an Activities/Experience statements.
- > No transcripts required or letters of recommendation accepted!
- > Application timeline for Fall 2026:
 - November 15, 2025: Application deadline. There is no early decision or early action
 - March 1-15, 2026: Admission notification period
 - If admitted, final transcript will be sent from Sammamish in July 2026. Admission is dependent on a strong senior year. Avoid the dreaded "senioritis!"

University of Washington Bothell

- UW Bothell uses Common App: <u>Common App website</u>.
- > UW has two required essays. Students must all prepare an Activities/Experience statements.
- > No transcripts required; NO letters of recommendation accepted!
- Application timeline for Fall 2026:
 - November 15, 2025: Early Application deadline
 - Regular Decision Deadline: January 15, 2026
 - March 2026: Admission notification period for regular Decision, Early Action decisions are made in January 2023
 - If admitted, final transcript will be sent from Sammamish in July 2026. Admission is dependent on a strong senior year. Avoid the dreaded "senioritis!"



COUNSELOR AND TEACHER REC's are required.

Use Naviance to "invite" teachers to write a letter of REC. Speak to teacher in person first!

Counselors don't need to be "invited" but students must submit the Counselor Survey in Naviance. It can be found in Surveys!

You must "match" your Common App and Naviance accounts!

4 Year Private Colleges/Universities



High School Transcripts- SENT via Naviance

Please look at your StudentVue Documents for a copy of your unofficial transcript

Request official transcripts in Naviance

Unofficial transcripts can be downloaded from Synergy

 Many public and private universities require students to send official

All classes taken or attempted must show on the transcript Transcripts Includes a list of all classes taken, grades and cumulative GPA

Some classes from middle school are automatically added to the high school transcript (i.e. Algebra, Biology, World Language)

Language credit can be
earned through
competency-based
testing – however some
colleges require that
students have courses
on transcript





"MATCHING" YOUR COMMON APP & NAVIANCE ACCOUNTS


- This will need to be completed to have your transcripts and/or letters of recommendations sent to any Common App schools.
- You do NOT need to match with any other application portals- just common application.
- Students must sign the FERPA waiver in the Common Application

Step One: Requesting Letter of Rec from Teachers






You will need a Teacher Letter of Rec for some Common App schools!



Ask your teacher in person first!



Requesting Letter of Recommendation from Teachers



Counselors ONLY send Letter of Rec to some common app schools (NOT UW). We can discuss in your Senior Blitz appointment

Make sure you have submitted your SHS Counselor Letter of Rec Survey/Brag Sheet to your counselor 3 weeks prior to your first deadline.

Requesting letter of Rec from your School Counselor

Counselor letters: focus on student's personal strengths and how she or he has contributed to the school community.

We do not use the coalition application portal. Do not request letters or transcripts in the Coalition

Not every student needs a counselor letter! We will help you decide if you need one!



College App FAQ

What is the Senior class size?

• There are **348** Students in the Senior Class

Are GPA's weighted or unweighted? What is my class rank?

• All GPAs are unweighted, and we do not Rank.

How do we request a letter of recommendation from our counselor?

• Complete the SHS counselor LOR survey in Naviance.

What do I do if I still need help picking colleges?

• Email Ms. Lopez-Kopp at lopezk@bsd405.org

How do I send my SAT/ACT scores (if required)?

Students send scores through College Board or ACT website. Most colleges are test optional for admissions this year

When is my Senior Blitz appointment?

 Check the main office window for the schedule and watch for the pass to come to your classroom!




