- 1. Make sure you created a <u>Common App</u> <u>account</u>
- 2. Log in to your <u>SCOIR</u> account and follow the directions to connect your SCOIR and Common App accounts
- 3. Complete your Junior Questionnaire required for your Counselor Recommendation
- 4. Make sure you requested two teacher letters of recommendation through SCOIR

ACADEMICS



- Extra help all students should be proactive in seeking help. Teachers are available after school Monday through Thursday after school, and NHS Tutors can also be requested. Reach out to your teacher or Counselor for assistance.
- AP Registration all students enrolled in Advanced Placement classes need to take care of two important tasks right now. Students must register for their AP Classroom using the Join Code provided by teachers and login to myap.collegeboard.org. Secondly, all students must complete the MHS AP Agreement which is a Google Form that they received. This confirms that students will sit for all AP Exams this May. Information about payment will come after both these items are complete.
- **Dual Enrollment** Did you know that MHS offers 31 courses that qualify for MHS and college credit from seven colleges/universities. Last year, 121 students earned college credits in 184 classes. Please visit the Mahwah High School website at <u>Dual Enrollment</u> for more information. Students enrolled in these classes should speak to their teacher, those who are not should plan ahead for next year!
