CONTINUING EDUCATION SCHOLARSHIP

PURPOSE: The Craig City School Board has established a scholarship fund to provide two \$500 scholarships to Craig graduates for continuing education past the first year of post-secondary education/training. Selection criteria will include progress made toward educational plans, post-secondary academic/vocational achievement, school & extra-curricular involvement, and financial need.

APPLICATION PROCEDURE: Submit a completed application packet to **Craig City School District** by **4:00 pm, Friday, October 3rd, 2025**. **Applications received after the deadline will not be considered.**

The following items must be contained within the application packet:

- A. Completed application form/answers to essay questions
- B. Resume'
- C. Transcript of grades (2.0 GPA minimum) or evidence of acceptable performance for vocational school for the previous semester/quarter.
- D. Evidence of continued full-time enrollment for the upcoming quarter/semester.
- E. One letter of recommendation from a person not related to you.

SELECTION CRITERIA: Applications will be judged according to the following criteria:

- 1. Neatness & completeness of application (15 points)
- 2. Answers to short essay questions (60 points)
- 3. Resume' (15 points)
- 4. Letters of recommendation (10 points)

The scholarship recipients will be notified by phone or mail. A check will be mailed to a student's educational institution.
