Attendance Policy: Report absences to Maria Sessa in the attendance office (include student name & reason). For illness, students must be symptom-free (including fever-free without meds) for 24 hours before returning. Doctor's note required for extended absences.

Illnesses: Keep home if fever $>100.4^{\circ}\text{F}$, vomiting/diarrhea in last 24 hrs, strep (24 hrs on antibiotics), or contagious skin conditions. Notify nurse of contagious diagnoses.

Allergies/Medical Conditions: Students with allergies, diabetes, seizures, or other medical conditions must submit updated Emergency Care Plans, Medical Orders, and supplies before school starts. Medical forms are valid for current year only.

Medications: : NYS law requires physician orders and parent consent for any medication (prescription or OTC) administered at school. Students approved to self-carry (inhalers, EpiPens) must also provide proper documentation.

Sport Physicals/Arbiter: A physical exam within 12 months is required for sports. Upload forms to Arbiter before the season, district physician will review and approve.
