Pendleton County Board of Education / Food Service announced an amendment to its policy for serving meals to students under the [National School Lunch / School Breakfast Programs] starting the school year 2017-2018

Pendleton County School District Food Service will be participating in the National School Lunch Program and the School Breakfast Program. As part of this program Northern and Southern Elementary, Phillip Sharp Middle and Pendleton High School will offer healthy meals every school day at NO COST to the students due to the implementation of the Community Eligibility Provision for School year **2025-2026**. Students will be able to participate in these meal programs without having to pay a fee or submit a Free /Reduced Application. Your school that you attend will ask you to fill out a household application for other programs in the district.

This program allows all students attending Pendleton County Schools to receive one breakfast and one lunch daily at no charge for the school year 2025-2026

Students may purchase second meals and a la carte items during meal times, but (Must have money in student account or cash in hand)

Pendleton County Food Service has a “No Charge Policy” district wide.

Student second meal: Breakfast - \$2.50 Lunch - \$4.50

Adult’s meal: Breakfast -\$3.25 Lunch - \$5.05
