It is expected that all students arrive on time.

# of Unexcused Tardies to School	Consequences for each marking period
1	Verbal Warning
2	Warning (email from Attendance Secretary to student and parent)
3	ODR from the 1st PD teacher/Parent Phone Call
4	Twilight Detention (1 day) (ODR) and Parent Phone Call
6	ODR - Twilight Detention (2 days) and Possible Suspension of Driving Privileges
8	MIP (ODR) and Revoked Driving Privileges - Parent Phone Call
10+	SST referral, NEHS Tardy to School Letter, and ODR with further disciplinary consequences

-Students are expected to be in their first-period class when the late bell sounds. All classroom doors will be locked at the sound of the late bell.

- Students arriving late must report to the attendance office to sign in and receive a virtual Smartpass to gain entrance to class.

- If you are arriving late and do have a note from home/doctor, please present it to the attendance secretary when you arrive to sign in.

Students who are not in their assigned classroom by 7:42 AM or who report to school before 11:00 AM without an excuse are considered tardy and are subject to the above disciplinary actions.
