

Sam Barlow High School Senior Portraits

The 2025-2026 Yearbook Staff invites seniors to replace their student identification photo with a more professional choice. With that goal in mind, senior portraits are **due on or before December 12, 2025**. We hope you find a photographer who can give you images that last a lifetime.

Please don't confuse a "glamor shot" with a "Professional Portrait". Please provide the Yearbook with a Professional Portrait that includes only your Head and Shoulders.

It is important to remember that we will print around 800 books next year. You should provide us with a photo that will represent you for a long time. Things to keep in mind while selecting a photo for the yearbook:

The photo should be borderless and in a portrait orientation.

A solid background or a muted, hazy background will be acceptable. Stay away from walls and other distracting backgrounds.

Keep objects from obstructing your face.

The photo should be free from the photographer's brands or studio names.

Please refrain from using your hands and avoid using props.

A prop could include, but not be limited to: machinery, animals, hats, non-prescription glasses, or distracting backgrounds.

A photograph with clear focus on the subject should be chosen.

Refrain from submitting black and white photographs. Please choose a full color portrait.

We will ONLY accept digital photographs. Please provide a CD/DVD, thumb drive, or email the image to the yearbook staff. We can return media submitted by the student. No media submitted by a photographer or studio will be returned.

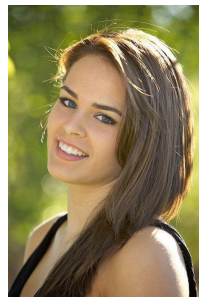
