The program is available to individuals without a bachelor's degree who:

- Have earned an associate's degree or completed 60-credits of required general education courses**
- Are currently employed as a school support professional in a Nevada school

***Students who have not completed all general education courses may be eligible for our pre-apprenticeship program*

Since its inception in 2021, more than 791 students have earned their licenses and now serve in Nevada classrooms.

Our undergraduate apprentices and alumni work in more than 170 schools across the state.

65% of our program participants are students of color and will increase the diversity of the educator workforce.
