

Winter Energy Assistance



ARE YOU ELIGIBLE?

The Connecticut Energy Assistance Program (CEAP) is designed to help offset the winter heating costs of CT's lower income households, specifically those households whose income falls at or below 60% of the state median income.

Your household may be eligible for CEAP if you can answer Yes to the following questions:

- Are you a Connecticut resident?
- Do you meet the following income guidelines?
 - You receive SNAP, SSI, TANF or other benefits from the Dept. of Social Services
 - Your annual household income falls at or below the income levels in the table below (i.e. 60% of the states median income)
- Do you have a social security number?
