State Seals

Citizenship Seal: Earn a score of proficient (3) on the US History and Government End of Course exams OR Earn at least a B in US History and Government OR Earn a score equivalent to proficient (2) on an AP social studies test OR Earn a "B" or higher in an appropriate CCP course

Science Seal: Earn a score of proficient (3) on the Biology EOC OR Earn at least a B in an advanced science class OR Earn a score equivalent to proficient (2) on an AP science exam OR Earn a "B" or higher in a CCP science course

Technology Seal: Earn a score equivalent to proficient on an appropriate AP test OR Earn a "B" or higher in an appropriate College Credit Plus technology course OR Complete one credit of technology courses

Honors Seal Meet the requirements for an honors Diploma with the OMJ seal.

College Ready Seal: Earn remediation-free scores on the ACT or SAT

OhioMeansJobs Readiness Seal: Earn OMJ Readiness Seal

Military Enlistment Seal: Two years of participation in JROTC OR Signed contract to enter a branch of the US Armed Forces upon graduation

Industry-Recognized Credential Seal: Earn a group of credentials totaling 12 points in a single career field

District Seals

Community Service Seal: Complete 40 hours of approved community service. Community service hours must be signed off by a non-family supervisor and filed with the school counseling office

Fine Arts Seal: Complete two credits of visual or performing fine arts OR Participate in two high school drama productions

Student Engagement Seal: At least two years/seasons of active participation (as determined by club advisor) in a school recognized student organization or school sport

***At least one seal must be a State Seal**
