## ACADEMIC INFORMATION

Collingwood offers the British Columbia Dogwood High School Diploma, and Advanced Placement courses.

We promote health and wellness as well as a rigorous academic environment. Therefore, we limit the number of AP classes our students can take in the following ways:

- Grade 10: Students can take a maximum of 2 AP classes
- Grade 11: All students take AP Seminar and students can take no more than 4 AP classes
- Grade 12: Students can take no more than 4 AP classes

School policy requires all students registered in an AP course to write the corresponding AP examination set by the College Board.

## OUR TIMETABLE

Collingwood runs a “2-5-1” trimester system. All students complete their first 2 courses of the year by the end of October; finish 5 more courses (including all APs) by the end of May; and end the year with H Block.

For Grades 9-11, H Block offers land-based learning opportunities. For Grade 12, H Block is Collingwood U: an experiential semester to prepare for life after high school. Consequently, Grade 12 students complete all their courses and finalize their transcripts by June.

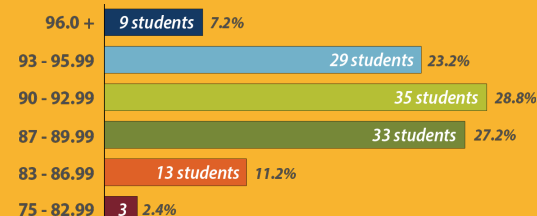

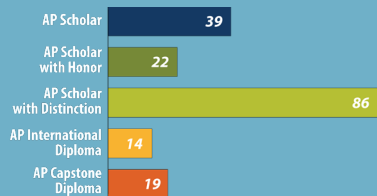

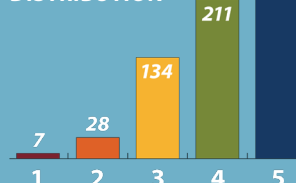
