
AP Exams and Policy

Students may take two AP class in tenth grade, three AP classes in eleventh grade, and four AP classes in twelfth grade. Students who meet certain requirements may be allowed to take additional AP classes.

Students enrolled in AP courses are required to take the corresponding AP exam. Ninety-five percent of the class of 2025 took at least one AP exam.
