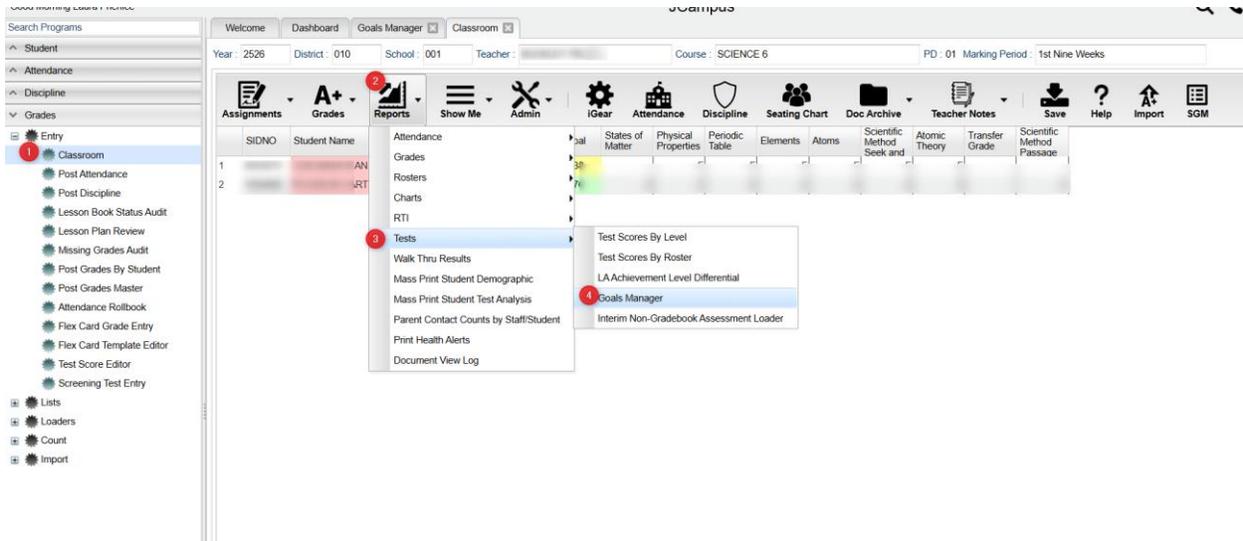
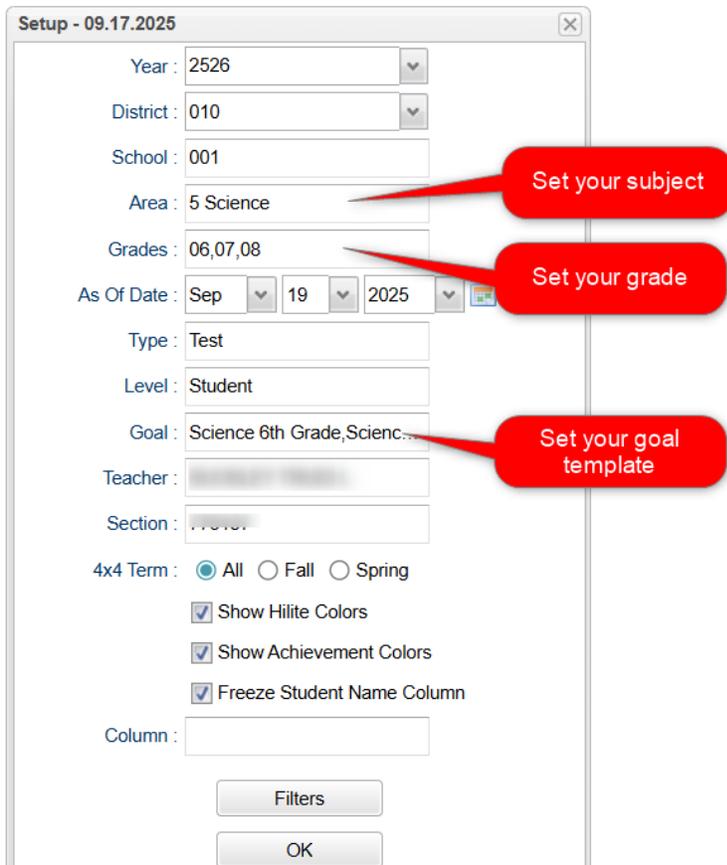

# GOALS MANAGER IN JCAMPUS

Save valuable work hours on calculating SPS scores and teacher SLT's utilizing the elements in Goals Manager.

**1** SPED, 504, ELL Columns

These columns indicate if the student is a SPED, 504, or ELL student.

**2** Goal

The Score and Achievement Level Goal assigned to the student. This value represents the target score for the student's end of the year assessment.

**3** AI

State Assessment Index points. Point values: 80 for Basic, 100 for Mastery, and 150 for Advanced.

**4** Note

Click in this cell to add or edit a note. For example, this can be used to give more detailed information on why a teacher assigned a higher/lower goal to the student.

**5** Low D

This number represents how many points the student needs to exit the Low 25 for the **District**.

**6** Low S

This number represents how many points the student needs to exit the Low 25 for the **School**.

**7** B Score

Baseline Score shows the student's previous score for the selected baseline assessment associated with this Goal.

**8** L/H

Baseline Low/High indicates whether the baseline score is in the low or high range of the achievement level.

**9** PTH

Points to the next half level achievement. This indicates how many points are required to enter the next half achievement level.

**10** Interim(s)

Assessments that measure student progress throughout the course.

**11** Baseline

All numbers in this row indicate prior year LEAP scores related to the selected Goal.

**12** Goal

All numbers in this row are related to the Goal for the selected section(s).

**13** Interim(s)

This row(s) indicates progress between baseline and final scores.

**14** Column Headers

These headers indicate the average score, half level achievements, and students for this Goal. Note: Clicking the **percentage** filter the top table to show only the students who make up that percentage.

**15** Profile

Click to view and print the Goals Profile for the selected student(s).

**16** Auto Load

Auto Load automatically sets student goals by assigning points that move them to the next half achievement level. It also shows additional points to be added to Mastery and Advanced baseline scores.
