

Attendance is crucial for student success, as each day in the classroom provides valuable learning opportunities. Research shows that students who attend school regularly have been shown to achieve higher levels than students who do not have regular attendance. The evidence indicates that it is how many days a student misses that matters, not the reason why they miss!

What can parents do to encourage good attendance? Try to schedule nonessential doctor, orthodontist/dentist appointments early in the morning, or late in the afternoon. Create a consistent morning routine for your student. Ask for assistance! We want your student at school every day and we are here to help.

We understand that absences can occur and that students may fall ill. When your child misses school, please submit a doctor's note or a parent note within three days of their return. Please note that parent notes can only cover up to five days per semester. Unfortunately, absences will not be considered excused after three days. Thank you for your understanding and support.

To recognize and encourage excellent attendance, we will be celebrating students who achieve perfect attendance each month. These celebrations are a great way to motivate our students and foster a sense of community.
