Superintendent's Report – Board of Education Meeting – September 24, 2025 - 7:00 p.m.

Ambitious Instruction – Classes are academically demanding and engage students by emphasizing the application of knowledge.

- NWEA/MAP Beginning of Year benchmark testing in Reading and Math is complete for our K-8 students and the resulting data will be used to shape classroom instruction and student learning
- Individual student performance data in reading and math (NWEA/MAP, Fastbridge) and SEL data collected (SAEBRS) are being utilized as part of our school-based Multi-Tiered System of Supports (MTSS)
- Gower's Preschool for All program received the Gold Circle of Quality; the highest award from ExceleRate Illinois, the state's quality recognition and improvement system for early learning & development programs
- College & Career Spirit Days will continue at GW & GM with monthly spirit day announcements focused on different career pathways of some of our very own Gower Graduates
- Our 8th grade students participated in Teen Sexual Health on 9/19 and our 5th grade students and parents will be participating in our annual <u>Understanding Changes</u> on 10/8 led by Candor Health Education
- The Illinois Learning Standards illustrate what students should know and be able to do by subject and grade Supportive Environment – The school environment is safe, clean and conducive to student learning. Teachers have high expectations for students. Students have the support of their teachers as well as their peers.
 - Year to date attendance: 94.2% (94.0%) for GW (K-4; K-95% [88%]; 1st-94% [91%]); 96.0% (96.2%) for GM; 97.0% (97.4%) - Teaching Staff and 98.9% (98.4%) for Student Support Staff. Previous year data
 - CPR/AED Training was held on 8/21 and 9/24 for support staff, admin, coaches, teachers, and bus drivers.
 - GM is in Year 4 of their 'Gower Houses' approach. Visit the GM Student Resources tab to learn more. GW is heading into Year 3 of a similar 'Gower Families' approach to promote team building and school spirit
 - Required staff trainings in Sept. were completed (9/9 and 9/16) by school nurses on: cardiac response plans, asthma, diabetes, food allergy, anaphylactic shock guidelines, and seizure protocols
 - Our anti-bullying efforts include an online reporting system Tip 62 linked to school websites that allows for anonymous reporting (0 reports in 2024-25 or 2023-24; 2 reports in 2022-23; 0 reports in 2021-22)

Involved Families and Community – Strong relationships are built across the community to support learning.

- Our 2025-26 Curriculum Nights on Sept. 4th at GW and Sept. 11th at GM were both well attended and provided useful information for parents to gain a clear understanding of the student experience
- National Hispanic Heritage Month Sept 15 Oct 15 Let's recognize and celebrate the many contributions, diverse cultures, and extensive histories of both Hispanic & Latinx American communities
- GW hosted their Annual Grandparent Bingo Night on Sept. 18th Another well-attended community event!
- Gower will host a Health & Wellness Expo for Children at their Best with a parent presentation by Compass Health on September 25th from 6-7:30 pm at Gower Middle - We are excited for you to join us!
- Parents and families are encouraged to visit the Gower PTO and the Gower Foundation websites for updated information on ongoing activities
- Save the date for Gower's Multicultural Extravaganza 2025 on October 23rd at GM; sign ups are being sent home through the Friday principal newsletters

Collaborative Teachers & Staff – The staff is committed to the school, receives strong professional development, & works together to improve.

- Newly adopted 5-8 Math curriculum, Math & You, and 5-8 Social Studies curriculum, Voices and Perspectives are being implemented with new curricular materials for students to use
- Gower staff submitted the FY26 Illinois State Library Grant for and additional \$850 in funding to add to the Gower Middle Library collection (\$850 was directed to the GW Library last year)
- District Committee work continues and most recently involved our District ELL Team, Special Education Teams, and District Mentoring
- Our 9/19 Professional Learning is district-based and focused on Professional Learning Communities (PLCs) for all certified staff - PLCs are designed around the principles of continuous improvement

Effective Leaders – School leaders work with staff to implement a clear and strategic vision for school success.

- The Consolidated District Plan and the IDEA Grant (\$200,866) have been approved for the 2025-26 school year; Title II and Title III Grants previously delayed by federal action level have been submitted
- The final 2025-2026 District Budget is being submitted to the Board of Education for adoption
- The current administrative framework utilized for student placement and class size meets our teaching and learning priorities and accounts for local and state budgetary guidelines (Appendix A)
- ISBE Evidence Based Funding Calculations indicate Gower's 'Percent of Adequacy' for student funding was 116% for FY26 and resulted in \$602,638.01; FY25 = 117%/\$601,778.46; FY24 = 117%/\$600,976.75
- The Board Charter and Social Contract is an example of how the BOE approaches their collective leadership role and is organized to support the Gower Community and School District
