The Cradle to Career Alliance:

Since April 2023, PCD has convened and facilitated the Cradle to Career Alliance with organizational leadership from the CAIU. Harrisburg Regional Chamber & CREDC, and YCAL. Membership is free is open to all "sectors" which include, but are not limited to: business, education, post-secondary training/education, community, and government.

The collective impact model, has identified three key CAP goals for South Central PA:

- The development, access, and sustainability of an online WBL experience and CAP connector.
- The development of an accessible, time & talentefficient regional Career Expo.
- Sustaining the Alliance.

Currently, the Alliance has amassed over 200 members, many of who participate in monthly meetings, and help forward the Alliance's objectives.
