1. Narrative description of the Prop 28 arts education program(s) funded. (2500 character limit).

The e3 Civic High Prop 28 arts program consists of the following courses: Drama Drama is an introductory class where scholars learn the fundamentals of acting for stage and camera. Physical and vocal training is accompanied by instruction in the arts of improvisation, character development, stage combat, and stage movement. Scholars will also learn about major movements in world theater history and be introduced to various styles of performance such as Greek tragedy, Shakespearean drama, Commedia Delle Arte, and contemporary theater. No previous performance experience is necessary. Play Production Play Production scholars work towards staging a full production of a play in each semester. Scholars will be exposed to all aspects of the rehearsal and production process. Scholars must be willing to commit to some after school rehearsal as a prerequisite. No prior performance experience is necessary, though simultaneous enrollment in either Drama or Advanced Drama is encouraged. Screenwriting In Screenwriting class, scholars will learn the art of visual and dramatic storytelling. Semester 1 will focus on the fundamentals of creating compelling characters and authentic dialogue. In Semester 2 scholars will learn multiple act structure and plot development, culminating in the completion of a feature-length script. Throughout, scholars will engage in film script analysis as well as cinematic study and critique. Scholars will also explore the storytelling potential of emerging media and alternate forms of dramatic writing such as streaming television and graphic novels.
