

Glendale Community College High School Articulation Information 2025-2026

HIGH SCHOOL ARTICULATION

Your student is receiving this notice because they are currently enrolled in an Articulated High School class, which means they are eligible to request college credit at Glendale Community College for their High School course. Please see attached for further information on the Burbank Unified School District High School Articulated classes.

PROCESS FOR RECEIVING CREDIT IN ARTICULATED CLASSES AT GCC:

Students may request college credit consideration by completing and adhering to all instructions and deadlines, in addition to:

- Maintain the required grade of B or better for both the fall and spring semesters set forth by the agreement.
- Complete the Glendale Community College enrollment process by submitting their spring 2026 application <https://www.glendale.edu/apply>. *If the student took a dual enrollment course summer 2025 and/or fall 2025 do not submit another application.
- Once the GCC application is submitted, student will receive their GCC Student ID# within 3 business days. If the GCC student ID# is not received, check your email (including spam) for the GCC email with their 9-digit GCC ID #.
- Notify Ms. Dysthe, in a timely manner by email, dianadysthe@burbankusd.org or in person, if no GCC ID # is received after 3 business days from submitting the application.
- Once you have received your GCC Student ID # you may then complete the GCC Request for College Credit Consideration Google Form listed in the following website: GCC High School Articulation Information for Students; <https://www.glendale.edu/academics/career-education-programs/high-school-articulation/process-for-receiving-credit-in-articulated-classes>. The form will open November 1st, 2025.
- Upon successful completion of the CTE High School course (grade of B or better both semesters), GCC will post college credit on the student's GCC transcript by August 2026.

*Note Credit by Exam will be required for GCC Culinary Articulation Agreements courses. After high school, the student meets with the department chair or faculty designee for further instructions for Credit by Examination.
