CURRENT BUSINESS (Principal)

1. SSC Bylaws: Roles and Responsibilities

Waggle passed out SSC Bylaws Roles and Responsibilities. Waggle asked to adjust Terms of Service for Site Staff to be changed to “may opt to serve for more than two years”.

2. Elections (Vote)

Waggle called for nominations for Chair. Waggle nominated. Approved 9:0

Waggle called for nominations for Vice-Chair. L. Scott nominated. Approved 9:0

Waggle called for nominations for Secretary. J. Noll nominated. Approved 9:0

3. Review current 25 – 26 calendar

Mr. Waggle handed out the SSC calendar and gave an overview of what is happening taking suggestions to put on future agendas

4. Title I Budget Review

Mr. Waggle reviewed Title I for SSC. He handed out and reviewed the school’s priorities for Title I funding that was approved by the staff and a needs assessments that occurred. He spoke about the Parent Liaison position that was funded and the importance of it and parent engagement.

5. WASC Action Plan Review

Principal reviewed the WASC process with the SSC explaining what it is and why it is important for the school. He explained accreditation and what it means. THS is in its third year of the 6 year cycle and will have a mid-term visit possibly in March. THS will be a part of a pilot program for a new WASC process. Mr. Waggle shared the 5 areas for ongoing g school improvement.

6. Prop 28 Plan Adjustment (Vote)

Principal handed out and reviewed prop 28 funding, its purpose and that a change was needed to the allocated funding for resources. The original budget had money going to K-8 schools to build feeder programs in music, but we aren't allowed to do that. A Para position in the arts will be added to assist SpEd students who take Art.

- 2.1 referencing money for Geri Neylan contract was removed
- 1.1 was adjusted to reflect the previous entry stating that \$150,000 was to be utilized by K-5, K-8 schools for hiring of staff to build VAPA programming. This entry will now direct \$150,00 to Certificated and/or Classified Staff at THS.
- These changes will go into effect immediately.

Motion made to approve change By Scott, 2nd by Kaur. Approved 9-0
