Athletic Clearance Process

Step #1: Students **must** visit their physician and have a FHSAA EL2 physical filled out and signed. It must be filled out completely, and signed by parent or guardian, student-athlete, and physician.

Students **must also** have an EKG done prior to participating in any athletic activity as part of the clearance process. EKG results are valid for 4 years. Nicklaus Children's Hospital offers FREE EKGs for any high school student

Step #2: Students must create an account on NFHSLearn.com and watch the three FHSAA Required Videos:

- a. Concussion for Students
- b. Heat Illness Prevention
- c. Sudden Cardiac Arrest

Once completed, you must download each certificate after completion. This will be uploaded onto Home Campus Athlete Clearance.

Step #3: Gather all documents required for athletic eligibility

- a. FHSAA EL2 Athletic Pre-Participation Physical Form (5 pages)
- b. 3 completion certificates from the required FHSAA videos (see step #2)
- c. Proof of Insurance
- d. EKG results (Sent to you via email from Nicklaus Childrens)

Step #4: Scan page 4 of the EL2 signed by parents, student-athlete, and physician. Each required form listed above should be scanned separately as you will upload each requirement separately.

Step #5: Create an account through <https://athleticclearance.fhsaahome.org/> This is how you will submit all athletic eligibility requirements for each student-athlete. One account should be created per family using a **parent/guardian email address** as the account holder. Multiple student-athletes can then be added to the one main account.

Make sure to select **ALL** sports your student-athlete plans to try out for this year. `

Step #6: Athletic Office Confirmation

Once you have completed the online process, we will review your file. **This review could take 48-72 business hours—so, please plan accordingly and submit paperwork as soon as possible.** Your child is **not** eligible to participate until they are cleared.
