Dear Wilson CSD Families and Staff,

As we settle into the new school year, it's a wonderful time to reflect on the values we want to instill in our children. We often talk to our kids about the importance of being kind, but the truth is, children learn to be kind by experiencing kindness, not just by being told to be kind.

This simple but powerful idea is at the heart of our approach. We're committed to creating an environment where every student, teacher, and family member feels seen, heard, and valued. When children feel safe and respected, they are more likely to show respect and empathy to others.

How can we put this into practice?

- **Model Kindness:** The most impactful lesson we can teach is through our own actions. Let's make a conscious effort to be patient in the car line, offer a helping hand to a fellow parent, and speak to each other with warmth and respect. Your children are watching and learning from every interaction.
- **Acknowledge the Effort:** When you see a child share a toy, include a classmate in a game, or offer a word of encouragement, take a moment to acknowledge their effort. Highlighting these positive actions reinforces their importance far more than a lecture ever could.
- **Practice Empathy:** Help your children understand what others might be feeling. Instead of saying, "Be nice," you can ask, "How do you think that made your friend feel?" This helps them build empathy and see situations from another's perspective.
