- Of our seventy faculty members, seventeen hold Bachelor's, fifty-one hold Master's, and three have completed their Doctorate Degrees.
- Students from neighboring towns of Grantham and Plainfield join the Lebanon school district in 7th and 9th grades, respectively.
- Approximately 80% of LHS students attend college, with a strong majority opting for four year colleges, and a few graduates choosing to attend a two year college or continue post-secondary studies.

The City of Lebanon has a residential population of approximately 15,690 with a daytime population of approximately 40,600 people. It is situated on the Connecticut River in the heart of the beautiful Upper Valley region and is a cultural hub. As home to Dartmouth-Hitchcock Medical Center, the Norris Cotton Cancer Center, and many high-tech companies, Lebanon's business community is dynamic and diverse. The median family income is \$156,797, and the median per household income is \$134,205. (2023)

Grade Point Average

A student's GPA is based on all courses the student takes. In Honors, Advanced Placement, and college-level courses, GPAs have .33 grade points added to the regularly assigned grade points for each credit.

Special Offerings

Extended Learning Opportunity Program

Lebanon High School has an active Extended Learning Opportunity (ELO) program. Students may participate in independent studies, private instruction, performing groups, internships, community service, apprenticeships, online courses, and dual enrollment programs to earn high school credit towards graduation. The Virtual Learning Academy (VLACS) in NH offers a variety of online courses.

Math Program

The Common Core State Standards for high school mathematics are taught via an integrated pathway in our Algebra/Geometry 1, 2 and 3 (A/G) courses. Honors level classes are offered at the high school for A/G 2 and 3.

Hartford Area Career and Technology Center

Students in grade 11 and 12 are eligible to enroll in courses at the Hartford Area Career and Technical Center. Programs include: Health Services, Auto Technology, Autobody and Motorsports, Building Trades, Business Admin, Information Technology, Cosmetology, Culinary Arts, Design Illustration/Media Arts, Industrial Mechanics and Welding, STEM, and Natural Resources.

College Courses

Lebanon High School students participate in college courses at River Valley Community College and New Hampshire Technical Institute. In addition, students participate in dual enrollment programs online and through River Valley Community College.

STEM Internship


LHS has a semester-long STEM internship with Hypertherm and Fujifilm Dimatix available for seniors.
