



Medi-Cal Updates Starting 2026



Big changes are coming. Here's what you need to know.

Medical & Eligibility

Starting January 1, 2026



-  Undocumented adults **cannot sign up** for full Medi-Cal. Those already enrolled by December 31, 2025, will keep their coverage.
-  **Children and pregnant people are not affected**—they will keep their coverage.

Other Changes

- **Asset (savings) limits are coming back:**
 - \$130,000 for one person
 - \$195,000 for a couple
 - +\$65,000 for each additional family member
- In **2027**, undocumented adults may need to pay monthly premiums \$30–\$100 per month (not yet final).

Dental Care

Starting July 1, 2026

-  **Undocumented adults will no longer get full dental care** (like check-ups, cleanings, and fillings).
-  **Emergency dental care** (pain, infection, tooth removal) is still covered for everyone.

- Pregnant people will keep **full dental coverage during pregnancy and one year after birth.**

With Medicare and Medi-Cal (Medi-Medi), your plan takes care of your dental coverage.

Vision Care

No changes in 2026.

Vision services are still covered under **full Medi-Cal and Medi-Medi plans.**

Medi-Medi (Dual-Eligible) Plans

Starting January 1, 2026 – these plans will be in **41 counties.**

- One plan, one card, one phone number
- **All your care in one place** – medical, dental, vision, mental health, transportation, and long-term care
