Informational and Discussion Items:

1. Discussion Item: Principal's Update

- Smooth start to the year – Device deployment was successful, but we did have a delay in getting the cases, but they arrived yesterday, and students will get to take their devices.
- Shout Out to staff and community for increase in emphasis in not having personal devices during the school day. The most devices our school has had to take in one day so far have been 4.
- Enrollment numbers were about 30 students lower than expected which resulted in our building using 1.5 teaching positions – one general education teacher and half of a Connections class. Most students' schedules were able to stay close to the same with minimal disruption. 6th grade parents were able to meet the new teacher for Curriculum Night.
- SCG Funds have been allocated - \$30,000 Flex/SGC can spend that relates to our strategic plan. The goal is to spend these funds by September or October.
- Initiatives for the school year

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- Catching PRIDE – catching students doing the right thing and meeting/exceeding expectations. Data shows 93% of our students don't receive discipline referrals. We hope to recognize these students.
- SGC Training – All SGC members are required to complete this through the Canvas Course. Katie Kinsey added additional members to this course.
- Cross-Council coming up on October 3rd from 9 to 12. Judith Boneta will attend if there are additional slots, we will be notified.
- HMS 2024-2025 Highlights
- Students reading at or above grade level increased from 87% to 89.7% - our strategic plan goal was 90% at or above grade level.
- ELL Students reading at or above grade level increased from 59.8% to 71.5%.
- Students scoring proficient or distinguished in ELA increased.
- Students scoring proficient or distinguished in Math increased.
- 8th grade students scoring distinguished increased in Science significantly.
- 8th grade students scoring proficient or distinguished in Social Studies increased.

2. Discussion Item: HMS Strategic Plan

- The strategic plan is currently in draft form. Plan to approve in September.
- The plan looks at Graduation rate, reading at or above grade level, Overall Milestones Proficiency.
- We were encouraged to focus on similar goals as last year, so that is the plan. We will focus on typical growth in the following goals:
 - Enhance performance for all
 - Ensure impactful programming
 - Prioritize safety and operational efficiency
 - Strengthen workforce engagement
 - Utilize fiscal resources effectively
 - Deepen community connections
