Working directly under the supervision of a Mental Health Professional, the MHW is responsible for providing direct care, support, and evidence-based interventions within the Serenity Room (Mindfulness Room) within Seneca Valley School District. The Serenity Room provides a safe supportive space where students can practice mindfulness, manage stress and build healthy coping skills. The MHW in this location manages the room, guides the students in stress-reduction techniques and promotes emotional well-being in alignment with Glade Run's Sanctuary Model. In addition to leading groups and providing individual activities, the MHW connects students to further resources as needed.

### **QUALIFICATIONS:** *(Must meet one of the following)*

- Has a bachelor's degree from a college or university that is accredited by an agency recognized by the United States Department of Education or the CHEA in a recognized clinical discipline including social work, psychology, nursing, rehabilitation or activity therapies.
- Has a graduate degree in a clinical discipline with 12 graduate-level credits in mental health or counseling from a program that is accredited by an agency recognized by the United States Department of Education or the CHEA.
- Has an equivalent degree from a foreign college or university that has been evaluated by the AICE or the NACES. The Department will accept a general equivalency report from the listed evaluator agencies to verify a foreign degree or its equivalency.
- Must have acceptable PA State Police clearance, PA Child Abuse History clearance, and FBI Clearance and Act 168 forms.
- Must have a valid driver's license and acceptable driving record.
