## **REGISTRATION INFORMATION:**

- REGISTRATION DEADLINE: Thursday, December 18.
  The league is limited in size, so do not wait to register.
- LOCATION: Kearney Park and Recreation Office,
  1930 University Dr. (Ernest Grundy Tennis Center)
- ENTRY FEE: \$190.00 per team. Please make checks payable to "City of Kearney."
- HOW TO REGISTER: Teams can register either by phone (using VISA, MasterCard or Discover), at the Kearney Park and Recreation Office or online at <a href="https://www.KPRreg.org">www.KPRreg.org</a>. In order to be officially registered, a team must: pay the registration fee, complete a registration form (including captain's name, address, phone number, e-mail address), and have a team name (rosters are not due until the 1st game). Mailed registrations must be received by the deadline.

## **LEAGUE INFORMATION:**

- DAYS & DATES: January 12 late February
- Mondays & Wednesdays (Tues. possible)
- TIME: 6:30 10:00pm (times are subject to slight change depending on the number of teams that register)
- LOCATION: Sunrise Middle School & Kearney SportsPlex.
- MINIMUM NUMBER OF GAMES: 7
- AGE: Players must currently be in 9th-12th grade and not participating on a high school basketball team.
- LEAGUE FORMAT: Round robin league & post-season tournament.
- OFFICIATING: All games will be officiated by paid Park and Recreation Officials.

## **OTHER INFORMATION:**

- League is open to all 9th-12th grade boys & girls who are NOT participating on a High School Team.
- All grades and genders will be combined unless enough teams register to allow for separate divisions for 9th-10th and 11th-12th, or boys and girls.
- 15 participants max per team.
- This is a full-court 5-on-5 league.
- The team captain will be responsible and be the spokesperson for the team. As a team captain, please recruit players that display good sportsmanship at all times.
- A sportsmanship award will be presented to the team that displays the best sportsmanship throughout the season.
- The league is limited in size, and teams will be accepted on a first come, first serve basis. Don't wait to register! In order for games to be scheduled, teams may not be accepted after the deadline.
- Uniforms with numbers are highly recommended.
  Teams should wear like-colored shirts.
