

Florida School District CTE Requirements for Teachers

The requirements for teaching in Career & Technical Education (CTE) programs in Florida school districts include a high school diploma or equivalent, successful completion of the hiring process for instructional personnel, and eligibility for a Career & Technical Education Educator Certificate.

- **Occupational Experience:** A minimum of three years' full-time occupational experience or equivalent in part-time experience is required.
- **Education:** A degree in the appropriate subject area is necessary.
- **Industry License/Certification:** An industry license or certification in the appropriate subject area is required.
- **Verification of Experience:** Verification of occupational experience must be completed by former employers or customers, and must include dates of employment, job title(s), full-time or part-time employment, and job duties performed.

Educators must maintain their industry certificate, registration, or license and provide a new copy to the Employment Services Division Certification Department each time it is renewed.
