Synopsis: Based on the popular Disney Channel Original Movies, Disney's *Descendants: The Musical* is a brand-new musical jam-packed with comedy, adventure, Disney characters, and hit songs from the films! Imprisoned on the Isle of the Lost – home of the most infamous villains who ever lived – the teenaged children of Maleficent, the Evil Queen, Jafar, and Cruella De Vil have never ventured off the island... until now. When the four troublemakers are sent to attend prep school alongside the children of beloved Disney heroes, they have a difficult choice to make: should they follow in their parents' wicked footsteps or learn to be good?

Important Information:

- I am glad you are considering auditioning for this year's MS musical, *Descendants!* Below you will find information on everything you can expect, including links to all materials you will need. You will be needed for both days of auditions.
- Complete and submit your [audition form](#) by **Friday, 10/10 at 3pm**. This form requires a parent signature.
- You will need to reference the [rehearsal calendar](#) to complete your audition form. Review this calendar carefully with a parent before signing your audition/commitment form. Actors may have no more than 2 unexcused/unlisted absences from rehearsal, aside from extenuating circumstances such as sickness. I will do my best to work around **limited, listed** conflicts.
- **All auditioners should report on Monday, 10/13 for singing and dance auditions** from 3:30-5:30 in FA 230. (See additional information below)
- Auditioners should **schedule an appointment for their acting audition on Tuesday, 10/14**. (See additional information below)
- On both days, you may go to MS Clubhouse prior to your audition and return afterward, or you can be dropped off and picked back up immediately after your audition.
 - On day 2, students should report to the 2nd floor Fine Arts hallway 5-10 minutes prior to your scheduled audition.
 - After auditioning, you can report back to MS Clubhouse or to pick up.

Additional Information:

- **Music auditions 10/13:** Our music director, Mrs. Jean Phillips, will run through all of the audition songs for the group to sing together. Afterward, she will have each actor sing their chosen song individually. Here is a link to the [audition song choices](#), including sheet music, vocal & accompaniment tracks for you to rehearse with.
- **Dance auditions 10/13:** Our Choreographer, Mrs. Vanessa Davis, will take actors in groups to the Blackbox to learn a short dance routine. You do not need to prepare for the dance audition, just **wear or bring something comfortable that you can move easily in (including tennis shoes)**.
- **Acting auditions 10/14:** we will have acting auditions from 3:30-5:30pm in the Blackbox, FA 230. You will not have to be present the entire time. Use [this link](#) to sign up for **one** time slot in advance. Acting auditions will consist of scene readings. Actors may be asked to read from any of the [attached audition scenes](#). Click here for [character descriptions](#). To best prepare, practice reading the scenes on your feet, out loud, ideally with a partner.

Try reading all the different characters. Be aware of who is in each scene and what the scenes are about.
