1. Narrative description of the Proposition 28 arts education programs funded (2500 character limit).

This year was the first year of implementation for the site specific plans. Elementary schools focused on increasing music lessons for TK-6 grade students. Secondary schools focused on increasing opportunities in visual arts, theater, dance, choral, and instrumenta music. In addition to the increased 19.3 certificated full-time equivalent staff, schools hired 90 temporary employees (Coaches and Performing Arts Assistants I & II) who worked with students a total of 18,648 hours.
