Eanes ISD is a small urban school district located in the areas of West Lake Hills, Rollingwood and west Austin. We are committed to excellence in academics, extra-curriculars and co-curriculars, preparing students for life-long success through high-quality instruction and access to a variety of opportunities and experiences.

Eanes ISD serves approximately 7,400 students at nine schools: five elementary schools grades K-5, two middle schools grades 6-8, and one high school grades 9-12. The District also boasts an Adult Transition Services (ATS) campus for special education students who have completed state-mandated high school graduation requirements.

Our priorities center around success for all students, staff support, community engagement, safe and inclusive school communities, optimal finance, facility and asset management and strong governance and collaboration.



As a flagship college preparatory high school, Westlake High School holds a national reputation for excellence, and is included on the nation's best high school lists by Niche and U.S. News. Westlake offers 36 AP courses, 31 Honors courses and 18 post-AP courses. Electives are offered in both the performing and visual arts, STEM subjects, health science, world languages, athletics, business and in each of the core subject areas. Our comprehensive special education program offers classes needed for students who qualify.

Students score well on the Scholastic Aptitude Test (SAT) and American College Test (ACT), consistently exceeding the state and national averages. Approximately 99 percent of Eanes ISD's graduates are accepted into college.

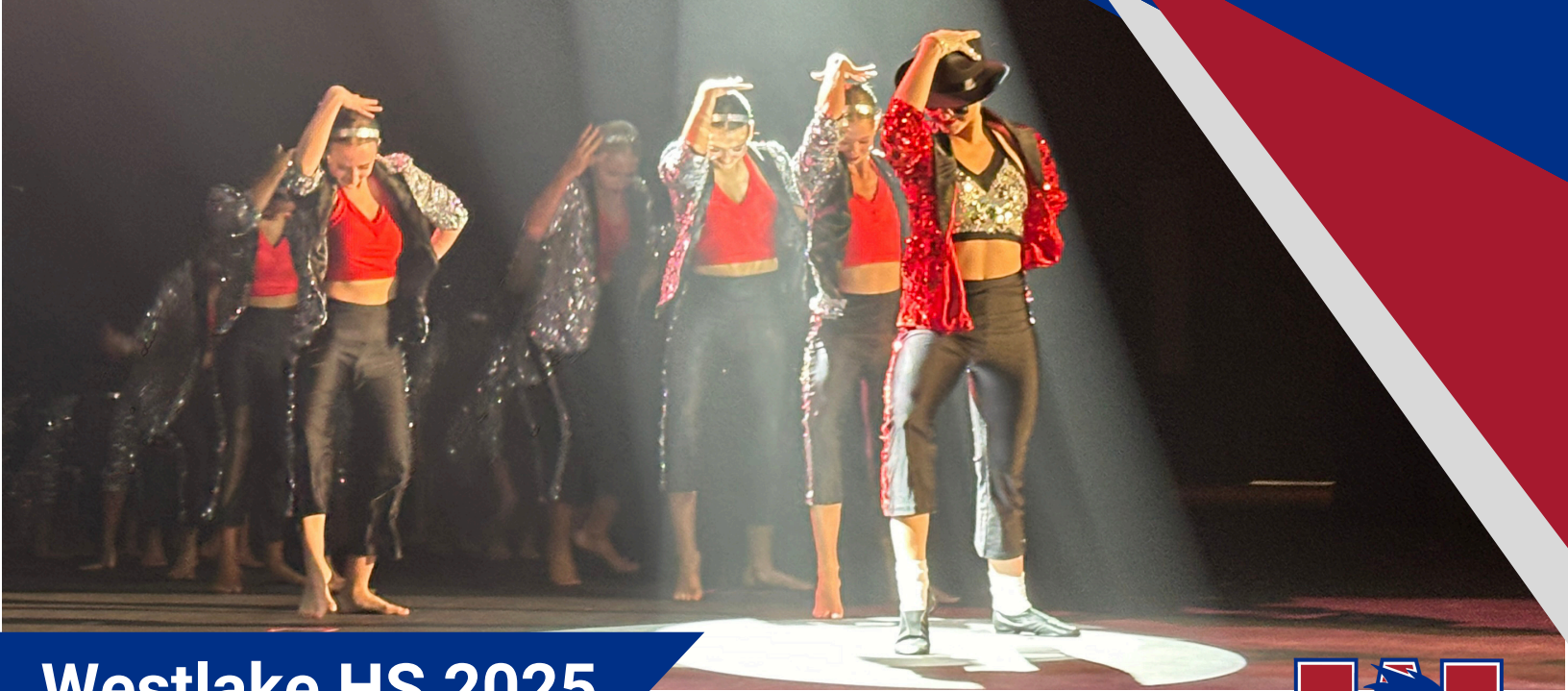
