## Graduation Requirements

<b>English</b>	<b>60 units</b>
<b>Mathematics</b>	<b>60 units</b> including one course beyond Algebra II
<b>Science</b>	<b>45 units</b> including Biology, Chemistry, and Physics
<b>Social Studies</b>	<b>45 units</b> including World History, U.S. History, U.S. Government, and Economics
<b>Foreign Language</b>	<b>30 units</b> including two years of same language in 9th-12th grades
<b>Theology</b>	<b>40 units</b> Two terms per year
<b>Business, Computer Science, &amp; Engineering</b>	<b>10 units</b> Two terms, one may be fulfilled in 7th and 8th grades*
<b>Fine Arts</b>	<b>5 units</b>
<b>Physical Education/Health</b>	<b>15 units</b> including Body Conditioning (9th grade) and Health & Wellness (10th grade)
<b>Community Service</b>	<b>40 hours</b> direct service to others
