Curriculum Notes

Math: Students will identify factors of whole number in the range of 1-100.

Accelerated Math: Students will convert customary units. Students will solve multi-step conversion word problems.

ELA: (Grammar & Writing) Students will be able to identify the rules for forming plural nouns. Students will continue writing their expository essays.

Reading: Students will refer to text evidence (details) to support the author's claim. Students will compare and contrast perspectives.

Science: Students will identify features on a weather map. Students will show what they know on the unit test.

Social Studies: (starting Thursday) Students will identify the main issues debated at the Constitutional Convention.

Student Success Skills/ReThink: Students will understand how trying their best can help them reach a goal.
