Curriculum Notes: What's Coming Up Next Week?

Math: Students will continue finding partners of ten. Students will also begin completing word problems to 10.

Math 2: Students will continue learning strategies to subtract with regrouping and apply the strategies to solve word problems.

Reading and Phonics: Throughout our reading this week, we will be answering the question, "What buildings do you know? What are they made of?" Students will read fiction

and non-fiction texts, discussing story elements, and what makes a text fiction or non-fiction.

Writing: The students will identify singular and plural nouns and write a response to a fantasy story using text evidence.

Science: The students are loving the first science unit. We will be learning about the seasons, meteorologists, and weather tools.

Student Success Skills: We will understand how mistakes help us learn.
