Taking the exam? HERE ARE NEXT STEPS.

Step 1: Go to myap.collegeboard.org.

If you don't have an account yet, click "Create Account" and follow the instructions. If you already have an account, just log in.

Step 2: Join Your AP Class Section, Your teacher should have given you a join code for your class. After logging in, click "Join a Course or Exam" and enter the code.

Step 3: Once you're in the class section, you'll see your exam status listed as "Undecided". If you plan to pay for and take the AP Exam, change your status to "Yes".

Only select "**Yes**" if you are committed to taking the exam and paying for it.

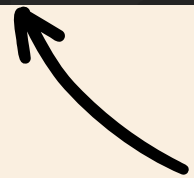

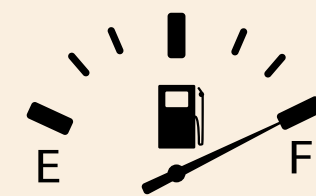
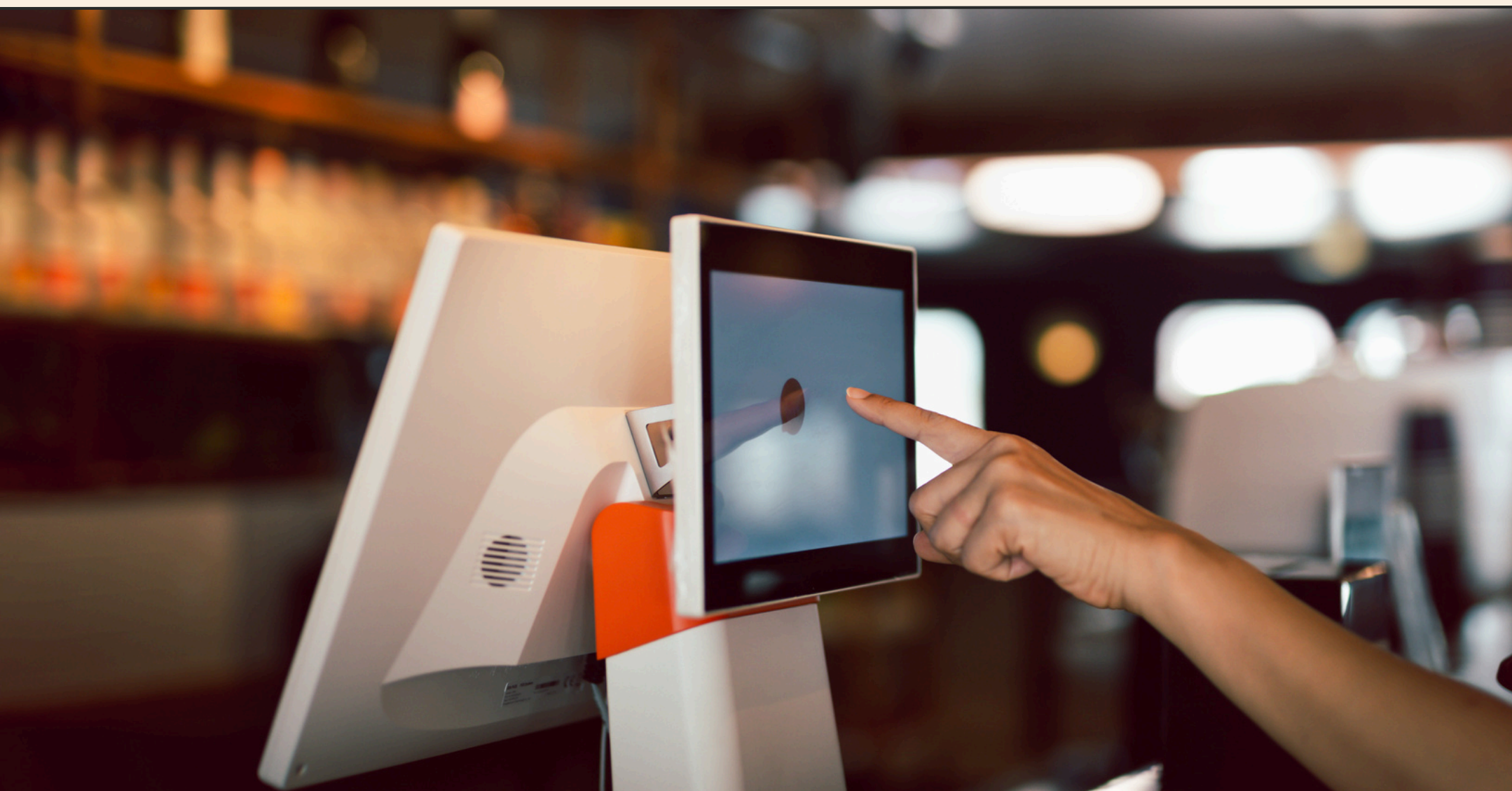

Pay in Full

Pay exam(s) in full. Costs less in the long-run in comparison to deposit/partial payment option.



Partial Payment

Minimum \$40 deposit per exam by November 1. \$2.75 fee for each partial payment made.



Fee Waiver

\$9 per exam and must be paid by October 31 or late fee included if paid between November 1-15 and after November 16. You will be temporarily on a waitlist to verify info.

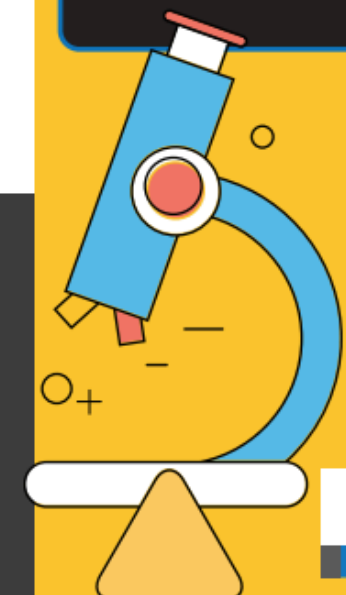
