



***Intramural Program  
2025-26 Season***

The Tussey Mountain Ski Area After School Intramural Program offers after-school skiing and snowboarding for students grades 4-12 at discounted rates. The program, which runs for five consecutive weeks, provides students with a weekly opportunity to ski or snowboard after school. Students can purchase a package that includes a lift ticket, lessons, and equipment rentals, or they can choose to buy only a lift ticket.

## Key Program Details

**All Registration and Packages, even if you have a Tussey Mountain Season Pass, must be purchased online. The program is sold as a five-week package, and families can customize it to include lift tickets, lessons, or equipment rentals. Students with a Season Pass can register for a \$0 option to be added to their school's roster and can purchase lessons at the program rate. A payment plan may also be available. All new participants will receive an RFID card that will be used for lift access, rentals, and lessons. This card is non-transferable and must be brought to the mountain each week. RFID cards can be reused from previous ski seasons but please login to your account on [estore.tusseymountain.com](https://estore.tusseymountain.com) to confirm the 5-digit customer code on the back of your child's pass matches the account.**

## Schedule & Duration

The program starts on January 5th, 2026 and runs for five consecutive weeks with the exception of school in-service days, with designated make-up days available at the end of the program period. Lift tickets are valid from 4:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m. on the assigned day for each school.

## Lessons & Ability Levels

Lessons are available for all skill levels, from "never-ever" skiers and snowboarders to advanced participants.

- **The first week** of the program will only hold lessons for beginners and those learning on the beginner slopes. These lessons may be 90 minutes long.
- **Subsequent lessons** are typically one hour long and are offered to all ability levels.

	Color	Terrain	Description of Student's Abilities/Lesson Focus
	Red	Little Bear	It's your first time skiing or riding. You're learning the basics, like how to stop and turn.
	Orange	Little Bear	Not your first time, but you're still getting comfortable with stopping, and you are working on turning more confidently.
	Yellow	Little Bear	You are able to link turns, and to navigate beginner terrain in a controlled and safe manner.
	Green	Deer Run	You're getting comfortable with faster speeds, and are linking turns with varied sizes and shapes. Skis are starting to match at the end of turns.
	Blue	Deer Run, Utah via Chicken Ridge	You can confidently ski or ride Deer Run, and are ready to try blue terrain. You can make short fast turns, and your skis are mostly parallel. Snowboarders are starting to explore riding switch.
	Purple	Utah, possibly Tuscarora	You ski or ride the whole mountain comfortably and are working on advanced techniques, such as carving.

### Additional Information

- **Meal Cards:** Tussey Mountain will be moving from Meal Cards to Resort Credit this winter. Resort Credit is tied directly to an individual's RFID card and can be purchased online or in person. Old Meal Cards will still be accepted in the cafeteria but for the best experience we recommend converting them to Resort Credit in the main Ticket Office or over the phone.
- **Lost RFID Cards:** A replacement fee of \$5 may be charged for a lost RFID card.
- **Transportation:** Check with your school's program advisor regarding transportation, as some schools may have specific busing arrangements for students. Skis may not be permitted on some school buses.
- **Family Participation:** Parents and siblings (typically in third grade or above) may be offered the same rates as the students in the program and can purchase their own packages. However, lessons are not available for family members.

## **Make Up Period**

**Any and all unused Lift Tickets, Rental Equipment, or Lessons must be used by the end of the make up period. There will be absolutely no exceptions and no refunds. The current make up period is scheduled for February 10th-13th and February 16th-20th. IM Participants are able to come out on any of those days to use remaining Lift Tickets, Rentals, or Lessons even if it is not the same day they normally attend with their school. The make up period is subject to change due to mountain closure or school cancellations. Typically, schools do not provide transportation for make ups. IM Participants will need to find alternative forms of transportation to the mountain. On make-up days, please check in with the main ticket office as soon as you arrive at the mountain so we may load your RFID card with the appropriate lift ticket and rental package as well inform our Ski School of your intent to make up a lesson.**
