

## Halls High School Freshman Academy Core Class Offerings

Freshman will take 8 credits/courses in their 9th Grade Year. These 8 credits will include the following: 1 Math, 1 Social Studies, 1 Science, 1 English, Freshman Seminar, Lifetime Wellness, Computer Science and an additional elective.
