

What is ranking and how does it affect the application process?

When a student is offered placement from the lottery: They will not be considered for placement at lower-ranked programs. For example, if a student ranks 10 programs and is offered placement to their #3 ranked school, they will not be considered for programs ranked #4-10. These campuses will have the status “Assigned to Higher Ranked Choice”. They will be placed on the waitlist of higher ranked programs. For example, a student offered placement at their #3 ranked program, will be on the waitlist for the programs ranked #1 and #2.
