2018 Levy Projects Status

 All 2018 Levy projects, with the exception of the Challenger Elementary School and Newcastle Elementary School HVAC Recommissioning, will be Substantially Complete by the end of August of this year.

2022 Levy Projects Status

 Work related to all of the 2022 Levy projects continues on an as-needed basis.



Larger General Fund Projects

Beaver Lake Middle School Elevator Modernization

- Although currently working, the elevator at Beaver Lake Middle School has continued to have problems and has been determined to need to be modernized.
- The project has bid and contract has been awarded to the lowbidder
- Work is scheduled to begin summer of 2026



Grant Opportunities

OSPI IGA Grant

- "OSPI per square foot to help pay for Investment Grade Audits (IGA)" grant which covers cost of the IGA's for both Skyline and Liberty high schools.
- Reimbursable funds have been approved by OSPI.

Dept of Commerce Energy Efficiency Grant

- Dept of Commerce related to the Clean Buildings Performance Standards (CBPS) at Issaquah HS. This grant covers costs of the Investment Grade Audit as well as several Energy Efficiency Measures.
- Retro-commissioning work is expected to wrap-up in late August 2025.
- Reimbursable funds have been approved by Dept of Commerce.

Dept of Ecology EV Bus & Related Infrastructure Grant

- Department of Ecology electric bus and charging infrastructure grant has been awarded.
- Infrastructure work is nearing completion.
- Buses have been delivered to ISD.
- Infrastructure is being installed and charging of new EV buses expected in mid-September.



New High School Update


- The Major Amendment application was submitted to the City July 1st which kicked-off the Major Amendment process (see full schedule of process on next slide).
- ISD and the Design-Build team continues, and will continue, to communicate with city staff during the amendment process.
- Target construction start date remains March 1, 2026
- Expected opening date of the school remains August 2027










SECOND FLOOR PLAN


THIRD FLOOR PLAN








ELEVATIONS - BUILDING EXTERIOR
