The program aims to provide individualized services to help every child meet their educational needs. The program provides classroom-based and itinerant educational services and related services (e.g., speech, occupational, and physical therapies) to students based on eligibility/need. If a child is eligible, they will receive appropriate educational services at no cost, funded by federal and state programs.

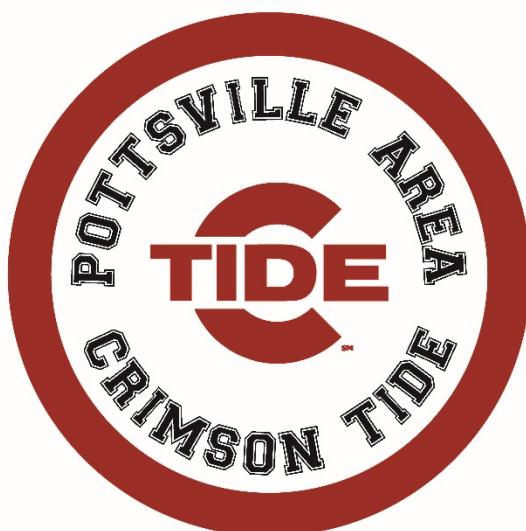

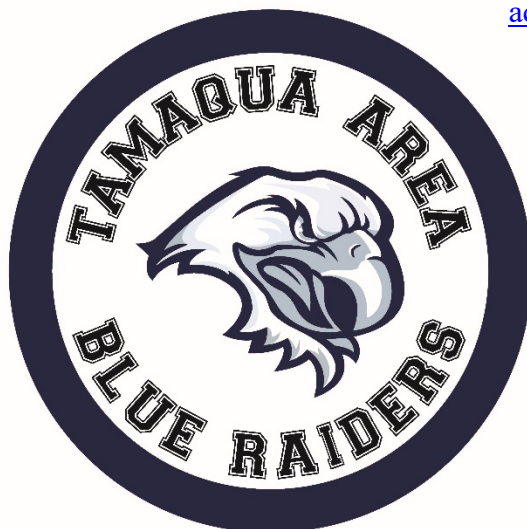
